The exhibitors will be limited to 1 fan per animal. No wood chip bedding allowed exhibitor to provide wood shavings or straw.

Exhibitors will rake their area 3' from all walls when released or risk being barred from future exhibition.

Age classification and group requirements are as follows: Exhibitor defined in certain classes; where a herd is registered in names of different members of family residing on one farm, and where herd in one unit, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor for GROUP CLASSES ONLY.

Bull.....	Calved after Jan. 1st previous year.
Grand Champion Bull.....	First Prize Bulls competing
Junior Heifer Calf.....	Calved Nov. 1st previous year and after.
Senior Heifer Calf.....	Calved between Sept. 1st & Oct 31st previous year.
Late Summer Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between July 1st & Aug. 31st previous year.
Early Summer Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between May 1st & June 30th previous year.
Late Junior Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between Mar. 1st & April 30th previous year.
Early Junior Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between Jan. 1st & Feb. 28th previous year.
Senior Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between Sept. 1st & Dec. 31st two years ago.
Junior Champion Female.....	First Prize Females from Early Summer Yearling Heifer, Late Summer Yearling Heifer, Senior Heifer and Junior Heifer Calf Classes
Senior Champion Female.....	First Prize Females from Senior Yearling Heifer, Early Junior Yearling & Late Junior Heifer Classes
Two Females.....	From above classes, owned by exhibitor
Three Females.....	From above classes, owned by exhibitor
Pair of Yearlings.....	Bull calved between Jan. 1st & Aug. 31st previous year and Jr. or Summer Yearling Heifer owned by exhibitor
Pair of Calves.....	Bull calved after Sept. 1st previous year & one Senior or Junior Heifer calf, owned by exhibitor
Best 3 Head.....	Both sexes represented, owned by exhibitor
Best 4 Head.....	Both sexes represented, owned by exhibitor
Commercial Heifer.....	Weights split – Possible 3 weight breaks to be split by office

SHOW RULES

Show Rules include all rules listed on previous page including the following:

1. Weigh-in time: 7:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Wednesday for all cattle.
2. Registration papers (for breeds) will be furnished at weigh-in time.
3. No Cattle will be allowed to show (regardless of birth date) that does not have all its milk teeth showing, or evidence thereof.
4. No stomach pumps.
5. Cattle will show in order listed unless otherwise posted.
6. Cattle will be divided into weight classes by superintendents and approved by the office.
7. If there are not at least 3 entries weighed for a breed, they will show as all other breeds. No show or scratched entries do not constitute an entry.
8. Cattle must weigh at least 1,000 pounds to qualify for market classes.
9. Market Heifer cannot be double exhibited in breeding classes.
10. The top 2 in each breed will be eligible for the top 2 overall Champion Class.

READ General Rules for exhibiting at this Fair in front of this book.

- ~Steers – if not at least 3 entries weighed for a breed they will show as all other breeds. No show or scratched entries do not constitute an entry.
- ~Steers Weigh-in time: (7:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.) Wednesday for all cattle.
- ~Steers will be divided into a maximum of three weight classes by superintendents and office.
- ~No steer will be allowed to show (regardless of birthdate) that does not have all of its milk teeth in place and no permanent teeth showing or evidence thereof.
- ~A classification committee will be designated to inspect and determine final breed of animals, if disqualified, animal will show as commercial (if female) or crossbred (if steer).
- ~**Classes may not be shown in the order listed in book.**
- ~Market Heifer cannot be double exhibited in breeding classes.
- ~Exhibitor to provide their own bedding. No wood chips! Straw or wood shavings only.
- ~Exhibitor to remove and dispose of twine and plastic bags. **Exhibitors to rake their area 3' from All walls when released or risk being barred from future exhibitions.**
- ~Cattle must weigh 1,000 lbs. to qualify for market classes.
